On July 13, 1995, the Bushkill Township Board of Supervisors adopted an Alarm Ordinance. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide standards and regulations for alarm systems in an attempt to minimize false alarms and provide the emergency responder with accurate and essential data.

Those installing new alarm systems will now need to apply for an alarm permit through the Bushkill Township Police Department for a fee of \$20.00. Those with an existing alarm will also need to apply for a permit for a fee of \$5.00. Alarm permits shall not be transferable from one individual to another or from one location to another.
